Birding in My Back Yard

Does your child enjoy identifying birds when you take walks? Birds are an integral part of our environment yet they often merely blend into the background. In this class students will gain a lasting knowledge of birds, their habitats, and learn facts about birds that make them unique among all wildlife. Students will experience a slide show presentation of Tennessee birds and their songs; enjoy a show-and-tell treasure chest of bird related items, including talons, feathers and nests; and learn to identify the birds in their school yard through a guided bird walk with close-up views of birds through a birding telescope. Students will also enjoy making various bird feeders to use in their back yard.

Resources sponsored by the Tennessee Ornithological Society will offer a thirty-six page *Discover Birds Activity Book* designed to inspire the student's curiosity and creativity while presenting facts about our feathered friends.
